MPower Your Inner Rockstar!

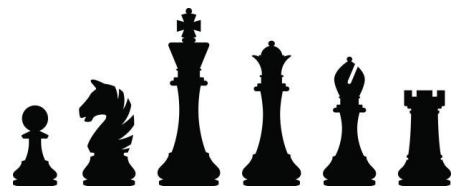

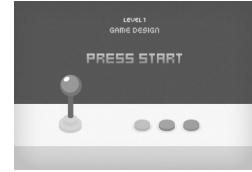
