

The Professional Development Program at Simon Fraser University is excited to offer four days of hands-on, action-packed activities this Spring Break from Tuesday, March 14th through Friday, March 17th, 2017 for students from grades 1 - 5 French Immersion or Francophone Programmes (CSF). The four days of French immersion or francophone program activities will run from 9:00 a.m. - 2:45 p.m. each day.

This unique opportunity is part of a wonderful community partnership between Simon Fraser University and School District 43. During the four days of our "I'ecole d'emerveillement," students will participate in a number of different activities such as cooking, crafts, indoor/outdoor games, dance, sports, science experiments, drama and of course, FUN. All sessions are fully supervised by Student Teachers in the Professional Development Program, as part of their teacher training. They will be working under the supervision of a certified teacher. Each session is designed to excite and delight participants with hands-on, creative learning opportunities to strengthen the connection of "wonder" and "understanding" of the world around us. This opportunity will be a French enrichment program through play.

The cost for all 4 days of activities is \$60 per student, which includes supplies and materials. Participants will need to bring snacks, a bag lunch, a water bottle (with their name on it), dress comfortably and come ready to have FUN.
