Communicating Student Learning:

Student-Parent-Teacher Three Way Conferences as a means of **Communicating Student Learning** are coming on November 27th-29th. Note that all forms must be returned (whether your child is having an immunization here at school or not) as there is a spot to indicate whether your child is receiving his/her immunization shots at school or in extreme cases (due to anxiety or medical history), at the nearby Fraser Health Unit.
