
Daylight Savings ends this weekend

At 2am on Sunday, November 4, please remember to turn back your clocks by one hour, to 1pm.

Traffic Safety Update

With the end of daylight savings, our body rhythms are out of sync and we are slower to react to unexpected situations. Please allow for extra time to get to school from WILLIAMS STREET to HENRY STREET to BULLER STREET to help ensure student safety. Our school day begins for many of our students at 7:30am for band and choir, not just at 8:30am when all students are expected to be seated in class, ready to learn! Also, please take care to adhere to the signage posting speed limits (30km/hr during school hours), rules of the road (No U-Turns!), and "No Parking".

Thank you for helping to keep our students and staff safe throughout the day. If we can routinely practice approaching school from Williams to Henry to Buller Street, the traffic promises to flow more fluidly. With the shorter daylight hours ahead and the potential for foggy, icy and slippery conditions, please be extra cautious and help us keep our students happy and safe.
