# **Parking and Drop Off Reminders**

Firstly, we would like to thank all of our learning community for their patience as we continue to navigate the difficulties with our parking, drop off and pick up situation. Caution and awareness when coming to and from school has indeed helped us get through the mess that is Buller Street. While we appreciate everyone's patience over the past several months, it is imperative that we continue to think safety first and at all times in and around the school. Here are just a few reminders to help us continue to keep everyone safe to and from school each day.

- \*\* Plan to arrive early or pick up a bit later so you avoid the main bulk of traffic in front of the school.
- \*\* Consider parking further away on William, St John's or James Street to minimize congestion at peak times. Students are very capable of walking a few hundred metres to school.
- \*\* NO U-TURNS PLEASE, anywhere on Buller Street or William and Henry.
- \*\* Please, do not park directly in front of the main driveway when dropping off or picking up! This is the main flow of student traffic and we want to keep it clear and ensure safety for staff and students at all times.
- \*\* Drive slowly and carefully at ALL times around the school. This is most important!

### Pro D Feb 22

Artwork by student Alice B, presented to the Pro-D speaker last Friday



Each year for our February District Pro-D day, our keynote speaker is presented with a piece of student artwork. This year, on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, an artwork produced by Alice B (Div. 7) was presented to author and humourist Charlie Demers. Alice's drawing of Van Gogh's *Sunflowers* was part of an Art Exploration exercise that Mr. Walker calls the "15 Second Drawing". For this exercise, students were required to look carefully at a postcard of a famous artwork for 15 seconds, then draw it based entirely on memory of the image. The exercise is primarily about developing visual memory, something art students and artists do all the time. From Alice's work, we can see that it's possible to create beautiful things through the briefest of encounters. It was suggested to Mr. Demers that while his time with SD43 educators was brief, the ripple effects were immeasurable.

# **Soapstone Creative Carving activity**

From Mar 4-8 and 11, EMMSOTA will have a visiting artist from Studiostone Creative where each student will learn hand-on skills, 3D thinking and cultural connections while carving their own soapstone animal. Taught by a professional artists, the students will be using kid-safe tools with water to prevent dust. As part of our school-wide mythology theme students will chose an animal native to BC to carve out of soapstone. These can then be tied to the many indigenous myths and stories that we will be learning during our mythology theme. Look for the display in the coming weeks to showcase some of the wonderful carvings the students have created!
