SchoolCashOnline, Student Activity Fees and Forms


ONLINE FORMS: Student Activity fees and Permission forms are due. Please complete your online permission forms and make the activity fee payment as soon as possible. It is very important that these forms are completed - if you are unable to receive on-line forms, please contact the office or your student's teacher to arrange for paper copies.

PAPER FORMS: PAPER Student Verification form and Emergency Preparation forms have been sent home. These forms are very important for us to update our Student Records system, and to use in case of Emergency situations. If you have not yet turned in these forms, we ask you to send them to school as soon as possible! This information helps us keep your children safe!

Our School District continues its full transition to ONLINE fee payments, permission forms and newsletters. We encourage all families to register for SchoolCashOnline. If you have not yet registered, please do so as soon as possible – click here: https://sd43.schoolcashonline.com/ Then click on 'GET STARTED TODAY'

Traffic Safety:

We are still seeing inappropriate traffic behaviours during drop off and pick up times. We strongly encourage all of you to think about student safety first. We are still seeing drivers Uturn in the middle of the street, stop in the middle of the street to let their students out of the car, and drive very quickly through the very obvious school zone. We once again strongly encourage you to approach Buller Street from Henry Street so that drop off for students can be on the East side of Buller ONLY. As always we thank you for keeping your children safe.



We would like to emphasize that traffic should follow Williams to Henry, then Buller. If stopping on Buller, students *must* be picked up and dropped off on the EAST side of Buller.

Online Orders for Hot-Lunch and Pub Night Tickets Has Opened!

Please login and place your hot lunch orders for **October 17**th **and 31**st. Ticket to the November 2nd Pub Night at Burrard Public House are also available online.

To place an order, go to EMMSOTA's Home Page and click on the link entitled "PAC Hot Lunch" (Right Hand Side, under the Heading 'Quick Links'). You will then be asked to log onto our service provider's, Munch-a-Lunch's, secure online ordering system. Below is some information for new and returning families to consider. As in previous years the online system will be the only way to place an order. There will be no refunds or cancellations after the order period has 'closed' (i.e. cut-off date indicated in the system). If your child is away on a day for which a lunch was ordered families are asked to attend the school to pick-it up over the lunch hour or send an e-mail indicating the lunch is being donated. Staff will distribute donated lunches to those children that may have a need.

- Parent accounts rolled over. As in previous years, we have rolled over all parent accounts (those who logged in during the 2017-18 school year). This means that returning parents can simply log in to their existing account (once you 'go live' with ordering). Also, we have removed all inactive accounts (ie. accounts that were not logged into during the 2017-18 school year).
- 2. **Note to returning parents upon first login**. Parents will see this message: "Welcome to the 2018-19 school year, please update your child's grade/teacher/div BEFORE ordering". The parent must complete this step before they will be able to order.
- 3. **If you have forgotten your login/password**. Please click the "forgot password" link on the MunchaLunch login page (https://munchalunch.com/login). The site will send you a 'reset password' email.
- 4. **Family has changed schools.** If a family has "changed schools" they can self-change to their new school. They simply login to their MunchaLunch account and they will see a "transfer schools" option. If they wish to transfer schools in the middle of the school year they can self-transfer by going to: My Family > Transfer School.
- 5. Family has children in more than one school. Note: if a family has children in multiple schools they must contact support@munchalunch.com and provide the school names. Our team will set up their second account. We may add a page which would allow parents to self-create a second account, but in the meantime please just ask parents to contact us.
- 6. **Split Family situations**. If a family account already exists for parent #1 (with a child added to that account: eg. 'Sally'), when parent #2 tries to create a family account and add THAT SAME CHILD to the account, MunchaLunch will allow it and automatically add a 'dot' to the end of the child's first name. So, if you see two occurrences of the name 'Sally' on a distribution report (eg. 'Sally' and 'Sally.'), this will alert you to contact the parent/s about any duplicate order and perhaps you may wish to not distribute the extra food to the child.

7. "Account already exists" message. The system ensures that parents do not create multiple accounts (to help maintain a 'clean' list). Sometimes parents create an account with a mistyped email, so when they try to login the next time using their correct email, the system will tell them that the account does not exist. If the parent then tries to register a second account (using their same first and last name) MunchaLunch will display a message that says 'an account already exists' to prevent them from creating multiple accounts. The system displays our support email so that the parent can contact us for help and we can quickly fix their login for them.

PAC Donations:

The Moody Middle PAC has decided to have a "by donation" fundraising initiative along with ongoing fundraising efforts throughout this school year.

We are asking parents for either a one-time donation, participation in fundraising events, or both throughout the 2018-2019 school year. Funds accumulated will be used to purchase "Wish List' items that staff and parents at Moody Middle decide will enrich our childrens' school experience. This year's PAC budget will be discussed and passed at the Tuesday, October 9, 2018 PAC Meeting.
