
Parking at EMMSOTA

We would like to thank our school families for their patience as construction continues on and around our beautiful new school. We do our best to communicate with the City and our private contractors around drop off and pick up times at ÉMMSOTA. We will do our best to inform the community of any changes that may impact the drop off and pick up of our students. As always, we try and ensure that our students are safe getting to and from school. We appreciate your flexibility and consideration for student safety. We have been meeting with the City of Port Moody and the independent contractors to come up with a new and improved pedestrian management plan to mitigate as many safety concerns as we can. WE will update you as soon as we confirm some of the most recent changes being put in place over the next week.

We continue to encourage all families to use William and Henry Street when accessing the school and **only dropping off on the East side of Buller**. We are still seeing too many students running out in front of cars in the middle of the street and this is **absolutely** not safe. Please take some extra care in the rainy weather and allow an extra 5-10 minutes getting to school in the morning and make plans with your children to meet you along Henry or even over on James Street after school. We need to do our best to limit the congestion and unsafe conditions for our children.

Winter Weather Ahead!

While the District tries to make the best decision with the information available, the weather does change quickly. Therefore, when schools remain open, decisions to stay at home during challenging weather conditions should be made by each family.

Schools are not routinely closed due to snow or other inclement weather conditions. All schools in School District 43 (Coquitlam) will remain OPEN, if at all possible, during winter weather, including snowfall.

However, on occasion, a district-wide or partial-district closure is required due to extreme weather. Partial-district closures affecting individual schools may occur due to the very different geography within our school district. If there is a partial-district closure affected, schools will be identified.

The decision on schools remaining open or needing to be closed, because of extreme weather, occurs **before 6:30 a.m.** so that families can plan and make alternate arrangements.

Any district-wide or partial-district closure will be decided and communicated by 6:30 a.m. via the School District 43 website www.sd43.bc.ca and CKNW AM 980 radio, CKWX 1130 radio and CBC (690) radio.

Extreme weather can also impact transit. Transit schedules may face significant changes or cancellations due to the weather conditions. Parents seeking information on transit schedules need to consult the Translink website: http://www.translink.ca/
