REMINDER ABOUT STUDENT ILLNESS

If your child is feeling ill in the morning, please keep them home for the day. If your child goes home ill during the day, please keep them home for at least 24 hours after their dismissal to ensure they have recovered.

When a student expresses to their teacher or the office that they are feeling unwell, the school may call home and ask that the student be picked up to go home. We do this in attempts to keep all students and staff healthy. Please check in and monitor how your child is feeling on a daily basis. To help lessen the spread of infection, if a student feels unwell, please have them remain at home until they are feeling better (without the use of over the counter medications such as Child's Tylenol). If they display flu or cold symptoms such as: fever/diarrhea/vomiting/sore throat/headache, they should stay home from school for 24 hours after the last occurrence. Thank you for helping to keep our school healthy!

STUDENT ABSENCES / LATES / EARLY DISMISSALS

If your student is going to be absent, please complete the 'Absence/Late/Early Dismissal' online form available on Moody Middle's website home page under 'Quick Links' or call the office at 604-461-7384. **If submitting an online form for an early dismissal, please remember to include the time that the student will be leaving.** Please remind your students that when they are feeling ill or want to go home, they should go to the office to have staff call home for parent permission to leave. Students should not be calling or texting parents directly as the office staff must speak with a parent or caregiver.

PHONES AT SCHOOL

Cell phones are important tools of communication. They are not, however, necessary for the day-to-day happenings at school. To help minimize distractions during learning and school time, EMMSOTA school policy asks students to leave their phones safely tucked in their lockers during school hours. This includes the morning nutrition break and lunch.
