Port Moody Amateur Hockey Financial Assistance Programs

Port Moody Amateur Hockey works with 4 organizations that provide financial assistance to our families that qualify for support. These charitable organizations will usually provide a \$400 grant per registered player and PMAHA will then top-up to cover the cost of Registration Fees for qualifying applicants. Please note there are still some costs to bear to play Minor Hockey. Team Fees fund team attendance at Tournaments, social events, gifts to team officials, etc, which are specific to each team; and in our A/Rep teams additional fees apply to cover paid coaches, carding fees and 1hr extra ice time per week.



KidSport is a national not-for-profit organization that provides financial assistance for registration fees and equipment to kids aged 18 and under. Through a confidential application process, grants are provided so kids can play a season of sport. Please visit www.kidsportcanada.ca for more information
