4. Load money onto the Smart Cash Card.
5. Your child is ready to shop and pay at the Book Fair!

By doing the lesson and passing
the quiz, students earn vaccines
for children in other countries.

The **How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ** lesson helps
students learn accurate information about vaccines and
strategies to make immunization day easier.

This lesson can be taught by a teacher or public health nurse.

Participation is easy!

Work with the public health nurse connected to your school to
arrange a time for them to come to your class and teach the lesson.
The lesson should ideally be taught within the week leading up to the
immunization clinic.

Help us evaluate the lesson and receive a \$100 gift card
for school supplies for your classroom!

We are looking for teachers with access to computers for their classes to help
us evaluate the lesson. To participate in the evaluation, teachers will need
to follow the simple steps in the Quick Start Guide to register their class and
create a team.

- ✓ Learn strategies to cope with anxiety around immunization day and needle fears.
