 - No anticipated need for mid-year cuts
 - No job reductions beyond those done April 2014
 - Carry-forward fully funded as of July 1/14
 - Minimum debt repayment of 2.5M > part of current budget
 - \$850,000 to cover Sept. 19 teacher pay has been covered in the budget
 - o 2015/16 "status-quo" budget, continue debt repayment
