4. Principal & Vice Principal's Report – 35 mins (Mark/Kathryn)

- Lots of information coming in from the Province. Teachers are being very supportive of the ever changing environment. Administration acknowledging and appreciating the staff.
- Only slight adjustments to the schedules have been needing. Desks are more separated. Masks worn at all time. Consistent reminder to students of protocols.
- Provincial Health and the Ministry have decided that there will be no more contact tracing.
- Ask that families continue to do their daily health checks.
- Badminton and Basketball have started. This will be intra-school.
- Band and choir will start next week.
- Lorna Moffat is our artist in residence. Students will be asked to bring a textile from home and also a plastic bag.
- Our Blues Berries Art Starts performance was cancelled. (We have another one coming up and hopefully that will go as it is a Metis Dance performance.)
- Safety drills are happening as usual.
- Students, please bring mask as well as a back up mask in their bag.
- Please have students dress for the rain. Umbrellas are encouraged.
- Please be mindful in the parking lot. Please only drop off in appropriate spaces. New youth worker. Julia Ward working in Fire Pod with Mr. Budai. Also Heather James will be working at the school with Ms. Paquette (joining Adam Burghall who has already been here since September with Mr. Abello). Articulation: start the process transitioning to grade 9. This is exciting for some and stressful for others. EMMSOTA feeds into all 8 secondary schools. All grade 8s will participate in a walk about as well as parent meetings and virtual sessions.
