Library Learning Commons

Though all books are due back to the library on June 12, Ms. Leonard is encouraging everyone to keep reading over the summer months. Research shows that on average students lose about 20% of their gains in reading over the summer break. If you can't make it to the public library, there is another option. The Coquitlam School District has licensed Sora, a reading app for K – 12 schools. Sora has thousands of eBooks and audiobooks (many always available with no waiting!) to read and the app can be downloaded to your device. As an added bonus, you can add the Coquitlam public library to the app to borrow eBooks and audiobooks from their collection without needing a library card! If you do have a library card for another library, you can add that library too and be able to search them all in one app.
