I look forward to getting to know you and your child over the course of the next school year.

Kindergarten is an exciting rite of passage for children; and many parents look upon entrance into Kindergarten as the arrival of the *big boy* and *big girl* in their child. While this can be exciting, it is sometimes hard on parents to relinquish some of the decision-making control to their once completely dependent children. Willfulness and independence, albeit helpful later on in life, isn't easy to parent. If you find yourselves engaged in battles of will with your kindergartener, perhaps consider celebrating your child's new-found desire to exert control, by encouraging input around clothing to be worn or snacks to be chosen. If your child is anxious about beginning school, please don't be alarmed or surprised by this. Some children lament their departure from preschool or daycare, while others are concerned about being away from Mom and Dad for the first time. Those with older siblings at Mountain Meadows may feel a part of our school community already.

Regardless of your child's specific circumstances, we will all work together to ensure that your child feels included, valued and welcomed in our learning community. While our office will be closed until the week before school resumes, please consider visiting our school playground several times over the course of the summer months to get your child used to being on MME school property. Feel free to telephone our office the week before our September 5th starting date, should you wish to bring your child by for a quick visit.

Most importantly, follow your child's lead. Discuss the imminence of Kindergarten only as much as your child is willing. Pushing the topic if your child isn't ready will only prove to be counter-productive if your child is feeling anxious about starting school. School Supplies

School supplies will be purchased in bulk by our Kindergarten teachers, and these will be shared by students in each of our kindergarten classrooms. Our teachers will determine the cost per student, and this will be communicated to families early in the fall.

Week One and Beyond for the Kindies

All Kindergarten students will come to the school several times over the course of the first 2 weeks. They may accompany their parent / caregiver for an attendance check on the first day of school (although the child's attendance on the September 5th attendance check is optional). The Kindergarteners will also come for one Welcoming Conversation with our team of Kindergarten teachers, and then will attend school for six partial days (extending the length of stay each time) from Friday, September 8 to Friday, September 15. The first full day of kindergarten will be Monday, September 18th.

Tuesday, September 5th: A parent / caregiver of each new Kindie will come to MME from 10:00-

10:30am (Kindie child's attendance is optional).

What: to confirm attendance, listening to opening day remarks from

the Principal, and to sign up for a Welcoming Conversation

with a Kindergarten teacher.

Wednesday, September 6th: Welcoming Conversations take place all day, from 9:00am, in rm. 219.

Thursday, September 7th: Welcoming Conversations take place from 9:00am – 12:00pm in rm. 219.

Friday, September 8th: Kindergarten Gradual Entry begins, either 8:55 – 10:25am or 10:40 –

12:00pm

Gradual Entry

All Kindergarten students are being placed in one of four groups (A,B,C and D) for the purpose of Gradual Entry only. Each group will attend Kindergarten for six partial days, spending time in each of our Kindergarten classrooms during this time. These groups do NOT represent your child's class placement. Class placements will be confirmed at the end of the Gradual Entry process, and will be communicated by means of a letter sent home with children on Friday, September 15th. The dates and times of each group's gradual entry schedule are specified underneath each group.
