FSA data, report card data and observational data indicated that Numeracy was a concern for our students. Since the implementation of our APL we have seen an improvement in students mathematical reasoning.

Planned Actions:

We plan to continue to complete collection assessment tasks in the fall and the spring with each homeroom grade 1- 5. We complete collection tasks with our kindergarten students in the spring only. We will continue with regular number talks and numeracy games in the classroom to build our foundational skills. We will continue to provide small group math support and will be using the results of the foNSI assessment to better support our struggling learners.

Teacher observataion around sucess and reduced anxiety around math Trends from FSA and Report cards



Classrooms regularly held numeracy talks organized by our department head and all divisions participated in a collection assessment task supported by the district numeracy team and our department head. We will continue to embed numeracy instruction into our staff meetings, Pro D Days and build support into our Learning support schedule. We are learning to use the FoNSI assessment to better understand our struggling student learning needs and plan to continue to support them with small group explicit instruction

Our human and social development goal around building a sense of belonging and connectedness is our most established goal, however based on our MDI data this continues to be an area of growth. We plan to continue and build upon our success this year of using our acronym for FALCON (Friendship, acceptance, leadership, Cooperation, Optimism, Nature and Safety). We hope that a connection to our school mascot will build connection and a sense of belonging. We will continue with all ongoing past activities to build connections such as spirit days, school wide events, movie nighs, and buddy classes.
