
West Coast Recess





You will not be able to place orders after the deadline date has passed for a specific lunch or treat day.



<u>Schoolcashonline.com</u> this website has all of our school based forms and payments like planners, fieldtrips and volunteer forms etc.



MyEducation BC: Log On (gov.bc.ca) this is the "family portal" where you will see Learning Updates (formally called report cards) this account requires you to change your password every three months. We suggest logging in to set it up prior to December so you can see your child's learning update right away.



Did you know you can pick up a waiver form at the office for your criminal record check? This waives the fee at the RCMP.

All volunteers need to fill out the forms on school cash online (link above) annually but the criminal record check lasts 5 years! If you have any questions please email Ms. Sander.
