# Mundy Road Bike Club

# Mundy Road is pleased to continue our tradition of having an after-school bike club for students in Grades 3, 4, and 5. Rides will be on Tuesdays starting in late April.

### **2025 Information Sheet**

Mundy Road is pleased to continue our tradition of having an after-school bike club for students in Grades 3, 4, and 5. Your child has expressed an interest in joining this club. Below are some Frequently Asked Questions about our bike club.

#### When is it?

- Tuesday April 22 or Wednesday April 23 (3:00-4:00pm) Students must attend **only one** of these **mandatory** clinics. Students must bring their helmet and bike for a safety check and participate in learning bike handling skills.
- Tuesday April 29, May 6, 13, 20– Bike rides to Mundy Park or Riverview Forest. Students can attend all or some of these rides.

**How does my child join?** Simple. Just show up for one of the mandatory clinics on April 22 or 23.

#### What happens if they can't attend the mandatory bike check or the mandatory skills session?

Unfortunately, attending one of these sessions is mandatory for the safety of your child and the group. If they do not attend, then they will be unable to participate in the rides.

#### What happens if they can't attend a ride to Mundy Park/Riverview Forest?

No problem. Students can attend as many rides as they wish.

#### How do I get a permission form?

They will be handed out at the mandatory clinic sessions on April 22 and 23. These permission forms need to be returned before your child can attend a ride to Mundy Park/Riverview Forest.

How much is it? It's free!

#### What kind of bike/helmet does my child need?

• Students must wear a properly sized AND adjusted bicycle helmet.

Their bike must fit them and be mechanically safe. A bike with gears and wider tires is preferable at the older grades, but not mandatory. Unfortunately, the school does not have bikes or helmets to loan children.

#### What are the risks of the club?

#### Will it be cancelled because of rain?

The mandatory bike and helmet check and skills session will not be cancelled because of rain.

The weekly rides will be cancelled if there is a rain or wind warning posted by Environment Canada for this area. Please ensure that you have a backup plan if the ride is cancelled at the last minute.

#### What are the behaviour expectations for the club?

As this is a school event, school rules and expectations apply. If your child receives additional adult support for their behaviour at school, then arrangements with Mr. Porter need to be made before joining the club. Please remember that all the coaches are volunteering their time to make this club a success.

#### Can I volunteer to help?

We would love that! Please email Mr. Porter (<u>kporter@sd43.bc.ca</u>) to let him know! All volunteers need to have a valid criminal record check and volunteer form on file at the office. Please contact the office if you have any questions about these forms.

Our goal is to send as many students to the track meet as possible.

The district track meet for our school is **WEDNESDAY**, **MAY 21**, **2025** at **Coquitlam Town Centre Stadium**. Permission forms for students invited to attend the track meet will be distributed on May 12 and need to be returned by May 15 (very important). We will require parent drivers to attend the track meet,



<u>Schoolcashonline.com</u> this website has all of our school based forms and payments like planners, fieldtrips and volunteer forms etc. This is also where you can pay for the kindergarten supplies.





MyEducation BC: Log On (gov.bc.ca) this is the "family portal" where you will see Learning Updates (formally called report cards) this account requires you to change your password every three months. We suggest logging in to set it up prior to December so you can see your child's learning update right away.

*Did you know* you can pick up a waiver form at the office for your criminal record check? This waives the fee at the RCMP.

All volunteers need to fill out the forms on school cash online (link above) annually but the criminal record check lasts 5 years! If you have any questions please email the office at mundyroad@sd43.bc.ca
