## Playground Update

Our playground fund is currently at $\$ 13,444.18$. Plans for Phases II and III are still being finalized, but will involve a free-standing circuit next to the SpaceNet with lots of overhead components. Our goal is to focus on upper body strength while replacing the play value of the old wooden structure. Phase II will likely cost about $\$ 33,000$, and Phase III a further $\$ 12,000-\$ 16,000$, depending on how much additional equipment is installed.

Meanwhile, we are in the planning stages of a playground donor recognition "tree" for the inside of the school. For some time now, we have been discussing how best to recognize the generous support of businesses, organizations, and individuals who have supported us in our fundraising goals. We hope to see something in place in the very near future!

As always, thanks to everyone for your continued support. The children of Mundy Road are loving the SpaceNet, and we look forward to replacing the wooden structure with something safer but equally enjoyable!!!
