## Welcome and Introductions

Approve Agenda - Shannon \& Hilary, all in favour.
Accept minutes from previous meeting - Teresa \& Dalene, all in favour.
Chair Person's report - Edna. Thank you: Shannon, Hilary \& team for first day coffee and treats, Dalene \& team for Welcome BBQ. Thank you Suzanne and Team for researching, choosing, and fundraising the Space Net. Also thank you to Ryan Bailey \& family for hockey game fundraiser. Our school is the winner of the BCCPAC Fall 2010 Conference prize. (A value of $\$ 285-\$ 350$ ). Our rep will have all fees covered.

## General PAC goals for year:

1. To support, encourage, and improve the quality of education and the well being of students. To this end we as parents want to strengthen the relationship between parents and staff. We believe that a teacher's job is hard enough - as parents we can help by lightening the load. Our role is to supply the manpower and resources, whether it be financial or practical, to help them achieve their goals in the classroom.
2. To continue to playground fund-raise to achieve phase 2: $\$ 26,000$. An additional $\$ 7950$ is required to continue the level of financial support that is provided to the school - $\$ 7100$ goes direct to school. Also teachers have direct access to some funds - per class; $\$ 100$ for field trips, $\$ 50$ activity boxes, $\$ 50$ discretionary class needs.
3. To continue to promote inclusivity \& education to all parents via regular email communication, parent ed workshops, \& encouraging all parents/caregivers to participate and be involved with their child's school.

## Principal's report

- Thank you for start-up festivities, very appreciated by new families.
- Class organization is set as of tomorrow.
- Fruit \& Veggie program great success - thanks to Teresa and team.
- Don Gordon/Math Makes Sense evening for parents: Monday, Oct $18^{\text {th }}$.
- Space Net a huge hit.
- Paralympic Athlete coming to school Oct 13.
- Need some Rainy Day Games -Kelly will provide details on math games. Playing cards welcomed. Possibly tennis or Hip Hop again if budget provides.
- Halloween activities will be on Friday, Oct $29^{\text {th }}$. November 1 is Pro-D. Almost all dates are on School District website.
- Continue to be in debt as a school, but far less than past years.
- School was re-roofed over summer but severe leaks. Parents might want to let the District Board know the leaking and floors are a concern to the health and safety of our kids. No graffiti over summer. Would like to increase the size of the back parking lot by losing two tetherball poles and moving fence. Trying to get fence enclosing courtyard removed as kids use it to climb up to roof.
- "Razz Kids" on-line reading program may be started up again.
- New Teachers: Mrs. Wood, Mrs. Fowler - librarian (temporary), Mrs. Lai - Music, Mrs. Karod, Mrs. Williams - Kindergarten, Mrs. Knittel - learning services.

Treasurer's report - Teresa:

- Received a $\$ 1000$ grant from Legion, $\$ 2000$ from Happy Days and $\$ 2000$ matching grant from Walmart for playground.
- $\$ 1249.78$ deposit from District for PST refund on the laptops was transferred into Computer Fund. $\$ 5020$ from Gaming Grant going into Computer Fund (\$20 per student). Brings computers up to approx \$14,000.
- PAC is interested in input from teachers regarding necessary upgrades to laptops, teacher computers.
- Motion by Diane: that PAC gives three full-time equivalents $\$ 50$ each to bring Discretionary funds to $\$ 650$. (Music \& library together $=\$ 50$. Counsellor $=\$ 50$. ESL $/$ Learning Assistance $=\$ 50$.) Seconded by Bryanne. All in favour.
- Motion to accept the Treasurer's report: Mary and Diane. All in favour.
- Stephanie Perko will ask teachers to write up a specific list of items needed in the classroom so parents can help buy or donate.

## Hot Lunch -Hilary:

- Pizza and Popcorn forms have been sent home. (Pizza Hut is making pizza fit within healthy guidelines: $50 \%$ less fat, $50 \%$ less salt.)
- Waste is a big issue from lunches - Mundy Road is on a Green Project through District, so this might apply to lunches every day, not just special lunches. Kelly will talk to Ken Porter and Suzanne LaFleur about how to deal with lunch waste.

Thank you to Stephanie Kane and Robin Juergensen for all their work on grant applications to date. (City of Coquitlam grant being awarded Oct 8.)
- Fruit \& Veggie Program - Teresa: Blueberries well received. Thank you to Tracy Grisdale for helping. All un-eaten servings should be returned and counted, or teachers note how many are left and then let kids eat them. Thank you to Teresa for taking this on.
