Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to a brand new year of fundraising to benefit our school community. Mundy Road Elementary PAC fundraises each year with the goal of enhancing the children's experience at school. The funds raised contribute toward many things that improve our school, for example;

Supplementing the cost of a field trip

There are several ways you can help out. Firstly, we would ask you to seriously consider making a **Tax Deductible Donation** to Mundy Road Elementary School. This kind of donation mounts up very quickly and makes a huge difference when planning activities for the year. We would like to recommend a donation in the range of \$35.00 per student (for families with several children in the school, we suggest \$75 per family). <u>Tax Receipts</u> are issued for donations of \$25.00 or more by the School District. <u>Business donations are also very welcome</u>.
