Fundraising & Tax Deductible Donations - 2011/2012

Dear Parents and Guardians.

Welcome to a brand new year of fundraising to benefit our school community. Mundy Road Elementary PAC fundraises each year with the goal of enhancing the children's experience at school. The funds raised contribute toward many things that improve our school, for example;

- Supplementing the cost of a field trip
- Offsetting the cost of school wide activities, such as-tennis lessons,
- Cultural events, and even new sports equipment.
- Providing activities for rainy day boxes in classrooms
- Teacher wish lists (perhaps making one of your teacher's wishes come true!
- Emergency preparedness
- Computers

Our Fundraising Goal for general PAC funds: \$9,600 How can you help?

There are several ways you can help out. Firstly, we would ask you to seriously consider making a **Tax Deductible Donation** to Mundy Road Elementary School. This kind of donation mounts up very quickly and makes a huge difference when planning activities for the year. We would like to recommend a donation in the range of \$35.00 per student (for families with several children in the school, we suggest \$75 per family). Tax Receipts are issued for donations of \$25.00 or more by the School District. Business donations are also very welcome.

Welcome Kindergarten parents.

Kindergarten is full day as you noted and all Kindergarten parents have been sent a welcoming letter and an outline for the week.

All kindergarten students are to come to school at 10 am (this is one hour later than students in grades 1 to 5). The students will have their attendance taken and teachers (all our Kindergarten teachers) will meet all the students.

The next 3 days (Wednesday to Friday) the parents of each kindergarten student have a 30-minute meeting with one of the kindergarten teachers (that time has been sent home to parents). Kindergarten students do not come to school for that week unless they come in with their parent(s) for that 30 minute meeting.

On Monday, September 12th Kindergarten students will come for a partial day, (8:50 to 11:00) and on Tuesday the 13th they will come from 8:50 to 1:00 pm- this will be there first day that they stay through the lunch hour!

On Wednesday, September 14th, Kindergarten students will stay for their first full day.

This gradual entry plan is in place throughout the district, for all elementary schools. It allows for our newest students to become comfortable and familiar with their new surroundings.
