December 2015 update: "On Nov 19th I had a meeting with Sean O'Sullivan with the City, constable Neil Roemer, Rob Wright and a few parents with regards to improvements on road safety. Collectively we have addressed serval issues. Sean was going to look into a couple of past studies on the Coquitlam Walkability Program and another study. He's going to get back to me on his findings. During our meeting Rob and I have said we'd like to see more signage on Austin to alert drivers there is a school and children may be present.

As suggested by Sean I've enquired with ICBC on funding or partial funding for a good sign to be installed on Mundy Street to remind drivers of the 30km per hr speed limit. Waiting to hear back from ICBC on this.

It's also been brought to my attention a couple of recent incidents in Coquitlam where a child was followed by an individual in a vehicle. On another recent occasion a Port Moody teenage girl was abducted and put in a vehicle and retained for an hour and a half. Luckily in all 3 cases the children were unharmed. I have contacted the RCMP and have requested they send me a "Stranger Danger" tip sheet for kids. Once I receive it I plan on forwarding this to Rob and he can send it out to the parents of the school."

At present, none of the systems in use at the school are owned by the school. They are "attached" to a particular student or a particular teacher. We would like one that could be assigned as the school sees fit.
- 2. PE equipment (\$700). We are in need of new volleyballs, especially given our volleyball team has been going well. We would also like each classroom to have some of their own PE equipment that stays in the class.
