# **Open Discussion**

## **Mad Science**

# **Pub Night/Carnival**

Not sure if we'll do pub night next year. Thinking about maybe a carnival or fair in the school. It would have a lot of moving parts. Christine Friend will head it up but needs lots of help with it to make it possible. Thinking of doing it in April. A big idea like this needs a solid plan. Other schools have done similar and have made a lot of money from them.

ACTION: Christine will evaluate it and if she wants to move forward will sketch it out by November 30. The PAC will review it.
