- 2.) I've been in touch with the Traffic Operations at City of Coquitlam on request of a couple parents at our school in regards to having a new marked crosswalk at Hillcrest St and King Albert Ave. Cars fly by without stopping for people crossing the street there all the time. By the end of this month a surveyor will check out this intersection and I'll hear back from the City on their findings and plans. There's a lot of foot traffic not just of parents and kids from Mundy Road but lots of high school students who frequent this route as well on their way to the 7-Eleven.
- 3.) I've contacted the Public Safety department at the City about their free and low cost Emergency Preparedness Hero's Programs which are coming up soon. Parent Education (Anita Krishna)

In order to be sure we reflect the desires of the PAC, we would like to hold a special meeting to vote on bringing Saleema Noon's Body Science and Sexual Health Education program to Mundy for Parents and Kids. Several options for the program are available. Whatever option is selected, this program will only be delivered to children whose parents have given permission for them to attend.

There are 3 program options for our school. **All options are preceded by a Parents Info session in the evening.**

Options 1 and 2 both occur during the school day.

Option 1 is a half day for the educators and involves larger groups with combined grades (k/1, 2/3, 4/5). Price \$750+GST.

Option 2 is each grade by itself and takes the educators a full day to go through grade by grade. Price is \$850 + GST

Option 3 is for the kids education sessions to happen after school or in the evening.

Addendum A: Saleema Noon's Body Science Program

Option 1: Half day till midday, Bigger groups, combined grades, we could do a schedule like this: (**Cost is \$735**, this includes the parent session plus a half day teaching till lunchtime \$700 plus 5% GST)

9am-9:30am K's & G1 combined (30 minute workshop)

9:40am-10:20am G2's & 3's combined (40 minute workshop)

10:45am-11:45am G4's & 5's combined (60 minute workshop) OR

Option 2: Full day where we teach the kids by grade, so smaller groups, This is a much more hectic teaching schedule for the facilitator but doable and allows for smaller more intimate groups. (Cost is \$850 plus 5% GST = \$892.50)

9:45am-10:25am G3's

10:40am-11:40am G5's

11:40am-12:10pm K's

1pm-1:40pm G2's

1:45pm-2:45pm G4's

As your school is small, it might be Ok to combine the grades. Up to you. It depends on whether you think it would be more worthwhile for them to have smaller more intimate groups (which is always nice) and if teachers/Admin are OK to use the whole day.
