Distributed copy of DPAC November 2017 newsletter
The Programme for International Student Assessment -PISA (oecd.org/pisa) is a triennial international survey evaluating the skills and knowledge of 15-year-old students. Canada ranked $7^{\text {th }}$, DPAC meeting powerpoint presentation noted District 43 ranked quite high in Canada, next evaluation in 2018

Special parent presentation for parents on February 28 dealing with a 3-tier foundational document related to student wellness and safety. According to DPAC, 90\% of district schools have students' wellness and safety goals as part of an action plan for learning. Does Mundy Road have one?

Rob - Our school goals revolve around social/emotional learning. Although wording may not specifically be the same, staff is trained to use restorative practices in relation to integration, identifying needs of restitution, and self-regulation. All of this falls under the heading or restoration and wellness. For example working together in circles to help kids identify what they need and what we need to be successful with a problem instead of punitive actions.

Emergency Preparation. \$75000 funding towards updating communication/policies in emergency binder and updating system including radios. The emergency operational center for district is at Centennial High School. District administration offices located in this area.
