Traffic Safety Information

Our school community is committed to having drop off and pick up done in a safe and consistent manner. Following predictable routines is a way to keep our students safe. I'm asking families to please be mindful of the following to ensure the safest conditions for our students and children:

10 Guidelines for a Safe and Positive Drive-Thru Pick-up/Drop-off Experience

- 1. Drive slowly on school property.
- 2. Stay with your car during drop off and pick up.
- 3. Respect no U-turns on Nestor Street.
- 4. Staff lot for staff, except 1 handicap spot with displayed sign.
- 5. No parking in front of bus/daycare area on Nestor Street.
- 6. Students exit on passenger side of your vehicle.
- 7. Check before pulling out to exit the area.
- 8. Right turn only onto Nestor Street when leaving.
- 9. Use crosswalks on Harwood Street and at the drive-thru area on Nestor Street.
- 10. Children need adult crossing on Nestor Street; no crossing in front of school.

Dressing For The Weather

Students will be playing outside at recess and lunch time, rain or shine. Please send your children with appropriate outdoor wear (including footwear) for the weather. Rain boots, rain pants, hats and umbrellas can help children enjoy their outdoor time even more. A change of clothes would also be helpful for some students. Even on rainy days and snowy days, the fresh air break is very beneficial for children's physical and mental health, especially right now when more outdoor play is encouraged.
