1.3 Chair Report

-Carly reported our current balance is \$44,000, enough to finish the playground?

-gaming account approx. \$8,500

-no longer use buses for track and field, tennis or Art Start (this year) nor KM Club, so most can go to playground

-site prep: \$14,800; Habitat \$97,426.46 for a total of \$112,226.35

-current financial: Parkland account is \$54,023.46, PAC account \$1,340.66; gaming \$8,500 and Variety Grant \$10,000 (Variety deadline is to install by August 2025)

-Variety Grant: Parkland writes a cheque to them for \$10,000 and they will pay the vendor \$20,000

-approximately \$38,362 remaining to raise

-upcoming expenses, \$1,200 for Hot Lunch, \$500 teacher gifts, \$500 staff lunch, \$200 Grade 5 ceremony

-contingency will be approx. \$3,400

-need to carry over around \$2,000 for next year

-all these numbers will be confirmed with our treasurer, Derek and Mrs. McKay can email the district we can go ahead

-by end of next week, want to write cheques, pull all in PAC account, and write cheque to Variety

2. **Principal's Report:** Sharon McKay

-waiting for cross catchment applications, approximately 245 students so far for next year, still 11 divisions
