Principal's message

I am excited about the start of the new school year and my second September at Pinetree Secondary. Hopefully families have had a wonderful summer break and students are recharged and ready to start another school year. We are looking forward to welcoming back our returning students and we know our new students will be accepted and embraced into the Pinetree family.

School START UP

The first day of school this year is Tuesday September 5th. Students attend "PACK" (homeroom) on the 5th. Our grade 11 and 12 students attend PACK at 10:00 am on September 5th for about thirty minutes. Grade 9 and 10 students attend PACK at 1:00 pm on September 5th for about thirty minutes. All grade 10-12 students are expected to have their photo taken on Wednesday September 6th for our school records, student identification cards and the school yearbook. (Grade 9 students will have their photos taken at the Grade 9 orientation on August 31st) Families are also able to purchase these photos from Artona. Our school yearbook is a colour history of the school year. It includes photos of all students by grade and many activities that happen over the course of the year.

An APP and E- FORM to keep us connected!

Please check our updated Pinetree website often for information about what is happening at the school. You can also download the Pinetree app for your smart phone to keep up to date on what is happening at school. We also use an automatic phone/email messaging system (Synervoice) to notify families regarding student daily attendance and important events and dates.

Previously,all students were given an agenda book at the start of the school year. This year we have moved to a smart phone app that offers us a digital version of the agenda book. Students and parents are encouraged to download the APP. (our paper agenda books are for our grade 9s this year and very few for those that still would like to use a paper version) We also ask that parents visit our website and go to the section for e-forms and fill out the e-forms listed there. This is very important for us as it helps us have up to date information and reduce our impact on the environment.

Parents should also note of the School Events Calendar for 2017-2018 on our school website and available in the Pinetree app.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is very important for student success at secondary school. We expect all students to be in attendance on a daily basis and ask that parents work in partnership with us to make sure that students are at school on time ready to learn. With the focus on attendance being so important for student success we request that families do not plan early holidays during the school year. Extended holidays attached to Winter Break and Spring Break can affect the ability of students to achieve to their full potential. Thank you in advance for supporting our staff as they work to give your child the best possible learning experience.

SAFETY and SECURITY

There are incidents of theft in every community. Pinetree Secondary is a community of over 1500 students and at times must deal with theft. As a school, we educate students to be responsible for their personal belongings and those learning materials issued by the school. The safest place and best plan is for students to secure items in their lockers in the A or B wing or if they are very valuable, keep them at home! **Students should not leave any valuables in the boys or girls change room lockers near the gym. Students should not leave any valuables unattended in classrooms, hallways and**

The school cannot take responsibility for student's personal belongings but we do care and will try and assist with lost property whenever possible.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

We are very lucky at Pinetree to have a great campus that allows our students' access to both the Community Center and Douglas College. To continue to have a great relationship with our partners we are asking students to remember that *we are visitors* in these areas. Our neighbors at Douglas College have asked us to remind our students that students can order food at Douglas and eat quickly and then return to Pinetree. The Douglas college cafeteria is not an area that our students should be hanging out in during their off block. It is only for students that have purchased food at Douglas. Our students should not be using it as a study area or an area to socialize. If students are hanging out or studying in the Douglas College cafeteria they will be asked to leave by Pinetree administration or Douglas college security. This year we are asking our incoming grade 9s to refrain from going to Douglas College for the month of September as they acclimatize to life at high school. We thank all of our students in helping us keep a positive relationship with our community partners.

COURSE and SCHEDULE CHANGES

Course selection is a process that begins with students in the spring of every school year. We ask students and parents to make informed choices around courses for the upcoming school year. This allows the school to plan and organize a timetable for the school based on student choice.

In June we sent a message home to all families of students going into Grade 10-12 about the limited ability of the school to make course changes. Students had the opportunity in June to do an online course request change form. The counsellors and administration reviewed all requests and where possible tried to accommodate requests. We will not be entertaining course changes as we start the new school year. Counsellors have access to all summer school results and will be making adjustments if needed because of summer school. *Parents and students should not be contacting counsellors about schedules and course changes. Counsellors will only be working on developing schedules for new students and will not be answering emails from parents and students of returning students that pertain to schedules and course changes.* We have had to make minor adjustments to our timetable over the summer and ALL students will receive a finalized copy of their schedule on September 5th.

Over the summer, Pinetree had an addition to our administration team. I would like to welcome Ms. Judy Payne to Pinetree. I know she is looking forward to meeting students and parents as we start another school year. We hope all of our students will set high expectations for themselves and reach for their dreams. NO RE-SCHEDULING OF COURSES

Course selection is a process that is started with students in the spring of every school year. We ask students and parents to make informed choices around courses for the upcoming school year. This allows the school to organize a timetable for the school. In June we sent a message home to all families of students going into Grade 10-12 about the limited ability of the school to make course changes along with a letter from our school district superintendent explaining this is a district wide challenge. Students had the opportunity in June to do an online course request change form. The counsellors and administration reviewed all requests and where possible tried to accommodate requests. We will not be entertaining course changes as we start the new school year. Counsellors have access to all summer school results and will be making adjustments if needed because of summer school.

Parents and students should not be contacting counsellors about schedules and course changes. Counsellors will only be working on developing schedules for new students and will not be answering emails from parents of returning students that pertain to schedules and course changes. We have had to make minor adjustments to our timetable over the summer and all students will receive a finalized copy of their schedule on September 5th

First Day Answers To Students' Questions

Where do I go when I get there?

Please use either the main entrance to the school, (that's the one off Pinewood Avenue directly across from the Fire Hall), the cafeteria entrance or the entrance from the overpass. Come early so you can be sure to get to your "PACK" room on time. We will begin on time and we expect you to be there.

What's my "PACK" Room?

Your "PACK" room is the room you go to every Wednesday with the same teacher; it's Pinetree's version of "homeroom". "PACK" will be the first class you attend on the first day of school.

Attendance

O ther than the academic lessons students 3 learn at Pinetree, attitudes toward prompt and regular attendance at school and work are among the most important lessons we teach students. Please help us teach your son or daughter healthy attitudes towards school and the workplace by:

- Phoning the school each day your son or daughter is going to be absent or late. Even if your son or daughter may insist that you needn't call, please do. We need to hear before the absence occurs whenever possible. Our switchboard is open daily at 7:30 a.m. Please call!
- 2 Minimizing the number of reasons for absence. We believe illness to be the only acceptable reason for missing school or work. Please arrange appointments, vacations and driving tests around school hours.
- Knowing your son/daughter's timetable. With our extended day organization, it will be less straightforward than usual as to when your son or daughter starts or finishes on certain days. It is worth the time it will take you to understand his or her schedule. Attend the "Meet the Teacher" evening, **September 27, 2017** — it will help you understand our schedule!
- 4. Contact the teacher. If you are concerned about attendance, in a specific class or in general, please contact your son or daughter's teacher or counsellor as soon as possible.
- 5. **Stressing promptness.** Being on time shows respect for the activity and consideration for others.
 - When each of us is occasionally, unavoidably late, it is our responsibility to: •hurry in order to be less late
 - •apologize on arrival for disrupting class •accept personal responsibility for being late.
