- ❖ ELL students should speak with their teacher about their next level or entry to English 10.

Graduation Checklist- Minimum Requirements

The BC Ministry of Education requires students to complete a MINIMUM of 80 credits in order to graduate.
(Courses at the grade 10, 11 & 12 levels are all 4 credits at Pinetree.)

Note: Direct entry to UBC requires a regular language 11 while SFU will accept a beginner language 11.

* The Indigenous grad requirement can be met by taking one of the following: English First Peoples (EFP) 11 or BC First Peoples 12

You may apply for a study block if you meet ALL of the following criteria:

- You have a challenging course load or extraordinary extra-curricular commitments
- You have a good attendance history (grades 9-11)
- You have a good record of citizenship
- You must be on track to graduate with 96 credits or more by June 2026

Responsibilities:

If a study block is granted to you:

1. During your study block you are expected to be studying on campus.
2. You **must maintain a minimum of 7 courses at Pinetree Secondary.**
3. You will not be able to further reduce your course load in September. (For example: if you choose to take a course online in the fall you cannot drop another course.)
4. By carrying less than a full course load, you will have fewer credits towards graduation. Your decision may impact your post-secondary options. It is your responsibility to determine how a study block will affect your post-secondary choices.
5. Read and agree to the responsibilities listed above by signing below.

A request is not a guarantee that a study block will be granted. Applications will be reviewed and approved by the Administration of Pinetree. By submitting your application, you agree that you have reviewed the guidelines and will adhere to all the responsibilities outlined above.
