
November 19th at Montgomery Middle School, Coquitlam (9 am to 3 pm)

Balsa Build	Come and learn the secrets of holding up massive amounts of weight with tiny bits of wood! This fun workshop will explore the principles with hands-on building!
Would I Lie to You?	Using creative and critical thinking skills to decipher the secrets of magic and mentalism! Magicians repurpose STEM concepts for their tricks and stage shows – how could YOU use them?
Bristle Bots	Create tiny little robots using vibrating motors and household items. Add bits and bobs to give your robot personality, or create a racing track for your little guy!
Science Alive (Electrics)	What makes our lights turn on? What is going on when our computers run out of battery? Find out in this exciting workshop on electricity and electromagnetic force, where we'll be exploring how circuits work in all of our electronics. We will spark your interest as we generate positive ideas about electricity.
Science Alive (Simple Machines)	Calling all engineers! This interactive workshop is about everything that spins, rolls, pulls, glides or can fly. From pulleys to levers, students will learn all about mechanical advantage, while testing out some inventions of their own.
