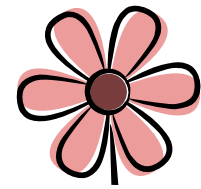

Good afternoon, PleasantSide families,

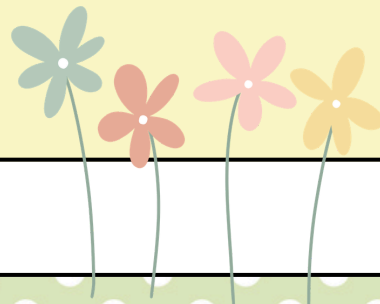
It has been another exciting and busy few weeks at PleasantSide, and we have so much to celebrate as a school community!
