

## OPENING DAY & WEEK PROCEDURES

Tuesday, September 6 ~ Friday, September 9, 2016

### Welcome back Porter Families!

*'Each child is a gift entrusted to us by her/his family.'*

Please read the following information carefully as it provides information about our first week.

#### Opening Week Schedule for Grades 1 to 5 students:

##### Tuesday, September 6:

All 2016/2017 Grade 1 – 5 students will attend school from 10:00 am to 10:30 am. Grades 1 – 5 students are to meet their previous year's teacher where they normally lined up last school year.

At 10:30 am:

- Grade 1 to 5 students will be brought back to where they lined up at 10:00 am and will be dismissed to their parents
- Teachers will let children know what supplies they should bring to school for the next few days, if any

##### New Students and Families to Porter:

New Grades 1 to 5 students and families are asked to come to our office. You will be met by Teachers, Ms. Turpin and Mrs. Faulkner, who will escort our new students to Room 12 for attendance. On Wed Sept 7 our new students are to report to Room 12, once again. They will, then, be brought to classrooms to meet and be with same age peers during the first week. To pick your child up at the end of the day please ask at the office.

##### Wednesday, September 7 to Friday, September 9:

Our day is the normal 8:55 am to 2:53 pm instructional day. Our 2016/2017 Grades 1 – 5 students are asked to meet their previous year's teacher where they lined up yesterday (and last 2015/2016 school year):

  - Fri: Mme LeBlanc (Library)
- Mme Squeo's last year's 2015/2016 French Immersion Kindergarten class are asked to line up as they did on Tues Sept 6. They will be met by:
  - Tues (10:00 – 10:30 am): Mme Squeo
  - Wed - Fri: Mme Rozanski (will be in our Music Room all week; Rm 19)
- Ms. Kennedy's (now retired) last year's 2015/2016 English Kindergarten class are asked to line up as they did on Tues Sept 6. They will be met by:
  - Tues (10:00 – 10:30 am): Mrs. Williams
  - Wed & Thurs: Ms. Moschetti (students will be in Room 17 all week)
  - Fri: Mr. Valente (Room 17)

##### ➤ Our 2016/2017 English Grade 5 students (last year's 2015/2016 Grade 4 students)

# LENGTH OF SCHOOL DAY & TIMETABLE FOR 2016/2017

**First COMPLETE day for Grades 1 to 5 students is: Wednesday, September 7, 2016:**

The legislated length of an instructional school day must be 293 minutes for Kindergarten to Grade 5.

**We have four bells that ring each day. They are:**

## **LINE UP BELL at 8:50 am**

- students will have a designated outside location where they are to line up, daily; they will be greeted and brought into the school by their classroom teacher
- The day officially (Instructional Time) begins at 8:55 am and ends at 2:53 pm
- Recess will be 15 minutes in length; 10:35 – 10:50 am

## **END OF RECESS BELL at 10:50 am**

- At this time, re-entry into our school depends on the teacher's practice; some teachers pick up their students at their outside location and some have their students simply enter the school on their own and make their way to class
- Instructional Time begins at 10:50 am

Lunch: EAT TIME (12:05 - 12:20 pm); there is no 12:05 pm noon bell

## **12:20 PM BELL: INDICATES TIME TO GO OUTSIDE**

- Lunch: PLAY TIME (12:20 - 12:50 pm)

## **LINE UP/ENTRY BELL at 12:50 pm**

- Instructional Time begins at 12:55 pm

DISMISSAL: 2:53 pm (no bell)

# KINDERGARTEN GRADUAL ENTRY PROCESS

## Tues Sept 6 – Tues Sept 13, 2016

The school year begins Tuesday, September 6, 2016 for our new Kindergarten students.

On Tuesday, September 6, our new Kindergarten students will attend school from 8:55 am to 9:20 am to confirm your child's attendance. Please take your child to the exterior door of the classroom of the teacher your child has been assigned to. These doors will be clearly marked on the classroom windows or walls

- ❖ If your child has been assigned to **English Kindergarten** with Ms. Natalie Williams please: line up at the south exterior doors against the south-west exterior wall
- ❖ If your child has been assigned to **French Immersion Kindergarten** with Mme Anita Bell please: line up at the south exterior doors against the south-east exterior wall
- ❖ If your child has been assigned to **French Immersion Kindergarten** with Mme Diane Squeo (M-Th) and Mme Constanta Rosu (F) please: line up at Mme Squeo's and Mme Rosu's exterior classroom door located in the middle of the east side of our south wing of classrooms adjacent to our primary playground

There will be staff and signs to direct you to the correct location. Your child will be at school for only 25 minutes on Tues Sept 6 so that we can say hello, welcome your child and take attendance. **THEREFORE, PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE SCHOOL.** Your child will be dismissed at 9:20 am.

Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup> will be the children's first full day from 8:55 am to 2:53 pm.

**KINDERGARTEN PARENTS REMINDER:** before you leave on Tues Sept 6 you will be asked to sign up for a 30-minute 'Welcoming Conversation' this conversation includes the teacher, parents and your child
