- Benefits of the Youth Credit Union Program
 - VCCU sets up a youth credit union in the school hallway on a weekly basis
 - Students participate by setting up teller wickets and deposit their allowances
 - Each student receives \$10 as an incentive to start each child's savings (distributed 50/50 between student and parent's membership share account)
 - Students receive monthly statements at home to keep them involved
 - Grace Yule to attend upcoming Staff Meeting to discuss feasibility and Nov 25 PAC meeting for more details!
 - **Technology Grant update:** Request of up to \$10,000 of PAC fundraising money to allow purchase of additional iPads, PC student laptops and the necessary software and accessories. This hardware and software would go towards supporting our students who struggle with written output challenges and would benefit from voice to text software.
