**2026 CMOLIK Foundation Scholarship** (\$50,000) is open to Gr. 12 residents of BC (lived in Canada for at least 7 years) that plan to attend full-time at a post-secondary institution or college. Applicants must have faced adversity, be ineligible for BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care), and have demonstrated financial need (total annual family income not exceeding \$80,000). To apply for this scholarship, you first must be nominated by Port Moody Secondary. Nomination forms can be found in PMSS Career Centre TEAMS, website, or Ms. Chang's office. **Western National Entrance Scholarship** (\$2500 - \$100,000) is now available for NOMINATION. Students need to be nominated by the school first in order to apply. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents with outstanding academic performance (90% average), demonstrated ability for creative and innovative thought, a demonstrated passion for the pursuit of learning, exceptional achievement in extracurricular activities and demonstrate commitment to community service through ongoing contributions to school and community life.
