NEW CMOLIK Award (\$50,000) is open to any residents of BC (that has lived in Canada for at least 7 years), in Gr. 12 and have faced adversity. Students must plan to attend and study full-time at a post-secondary institution or college and must demonstrate financial need (total annual family income not exceeding \$80,000). Applicants must be nominated by Port Moody Secondary in order to apply. The nomination deadline is Friday, January 9th, 2026. NEW York University – President's International Scholarship of Excellence (\$180,000) is open to international high school students (non-Canadian requiring a study permit) that are applying to York University. They must demonstrate strong academic performance (minimum average of 80% or equivalent) and leadership skills and active involvement in volunteer work and extracurricular activities.). Applicants must be nominated by Port Moody Secondary in order to apply. The nomination deadline is Monday, December 15th, 2025. Health Sciences Association Scholarships and Bursaries (\$2000) is open to applicants who are HSA members in good standing or the child of an HSA member who is continuing or proceeding in a full-time program in any field leading to a recognized certification, diploma, or degree at a public post-secondary educational institution. Applicants must demonstrate solidarity and leadership skills along with including a short answer response about benefits of a strong labour movement in Canada. If interested, apply <u>HERE</u> by January 9th, 2026.

2026 CMOLIK Foundation Scholarship (\$50,000) is open to Gr. 12 residents of BC (lived in Canada for at least 7 years) that plan to attend full-time at a post-secondary institution or college. Applicants must have faced adversity, be ineligible or BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care), and have demonstrated financial need (total annual family income not exceeding \$80,000). To apply for this scholarship, you first must be nominated by Port Moody Secondary. Nomination forms can be found in PMSS Career Centre TEAMS, website, or Ms. Chang's office. Please return completed forms to moodyscholarshipsubmission@sd43.bc.ca by Friday January 9th, 2026. If nominated, the completed application to CMOLIK needs to be completed by Saturday, February 7th, 2026. For more information, click HERE!
