Ceremony The Commencement Ceremony will be held on **June 21, 2014** at 11:00 am at the **Orpheum Theatre,** in Vancouver.

Student Arrival Students should arrive **an hour early** at for the processional and ceremony. Parents can enter **a half-hour** before ceremony and find their seats in the theatre. Tickets must be presented at the door.

Cap and Gowns On the Friday before the ceremony, grads will pick up their caps and gowns from the Drama Room immediately after rehearsal. We encourage grads to go home and take photos with their family and friends at this time.

At the end of the ceremony, grads are required to return their gowns **immediately** to the designated areas located **at the Orpheum Theatre**. Grads must return gowns or will be charged the replacement cost.

TicketsGrads do not need tickets, but all family and guests must have tickets. At this
time, we anticipate that each grad can purchase four (4) tickets for \$8.00 each.

Please Note Families should also be aware that this formal ceremony often lasts up to four (4) hours and is not suitable for small children who have difficulties sitting quietly.

Balcony Seating (Accessible Seating) The Orpheum is a beautiful and large theatre and there are plenty of seats for everyone. If anyone in your party needs to take regular breaks, you may find it desirable to choose a seat in the balcony, where elevators and washrooms are easily accessible and the view is spectacular.
