- A two page (500 words max.) typed personal essay: **one essay only, for all scholarships applied for using this form**. This is an opportunity to differentiate yourself from the other applicants by providing the committee information that has not already been mentioned on this form or in your letters of reference. See below for "Tips to Success".
- **u** Two supporting letters of reference; one from a teacher and one from the community.
- A supporting referee verification sheet for **each** school, community activity, or work experience listed in the Student Info section.
- The Financial Information pages ONLY if you are applying for scholarships/bursaries where you must show financial need.
- □ Your Grade 12 transcript. Order from Mrs. Boehmer in Office (allowing one week for delivery).

Tips for Success: How to Make Your Essay Count

- Focus on one activity or event; you have listed your range of accomplishments on the application form and do not need to repeat yourself.
- Portray your character, leadership ability, vision and what makes you unique. Give specifics.
- Be original but not bizarre: be yourself!
- Don't "thesaurisize" your composition, i.e. don't use big words!
- Spend time on the introduction: don't summarize but do create mystery and intrigue.
- Body paragraphs must relate to the introduction: conclusions are crucial!
- Do something else; spend time away from your draft to decide if you still consider your topic worthwhile.
- Get your family, friends, and teachers to edit and critique your essay.
- See the Career Resource room for more detailed tips.
