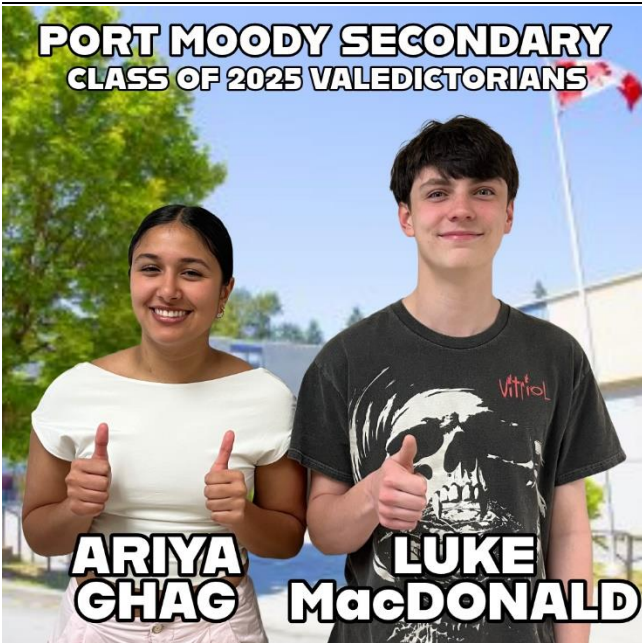
MATH CHALLENGERS PROVINCIAL FINALS
