2019 PSAT TEST: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16 – If you're thinking of college in the U.S. you will need either a SAT or ACT score for admission consideration. PMSS offers the Practice SAT to Port Moody students, an inexpensive way to prepare for the SAT. Registration fee is \$30, payable by cash or by cheque made out to Port Moody Secondary School. Test will start at 3:10 pm and takes approximately 3.5 hours.
