

REMINDER! UBC ADMISSIONS AND TRANSCRIPTS - Students who submitted their UBC online application **after December 2** must provide UBC with their Personal Education Number (PEN) and order a transcript
via <u>StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> **by JANUARY 31**. When ordering a transcript, applicants should select "Send my transcript now and allow this Post-Secondary Institution to request transcript updates" and choose the default date (one year from the date of their order), so that UBC can receive their interim and final grades continuously.

<u>CTA SCHOLARSHIPS IN LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PACKAGE</u> – The CTA application form for all CTA scholarships listed in the package are now available in limited quantities at the Career Centre, downloaded from the Career Centre section of the school website or on the App: Scholarships channel. If you are intending to apply for the CTA Merit Award, the CTA Cam McKenzie Award, and/or a CTA Student Bursary, you must also complete and return a *CTA Application* with your Local Scholarship Form & other documents by *March 6/2020*.
