

MYED FAMILY PORTAL ACCESS:

You should have received a brochure titled "Getting Started with the Family Portal" and we are pleased to announce that the MyEd Family Portal will be available for Port Moody Secondary parents and guardians to access. We have attached that brochure here as it contains everything you will need to get started with the Family Portal. We recommend that you save this document for quick reference in the future.

You also should have received an auto-generated email with your log in information. If you do not see a message in your email inbox, please check your junk mail. Using the directions in the email and in the brochure please log in to your account and familiarize yourself with the website. Please note that you will be asked to create a new unique password and set up a security question the first time you log in.

If you have students in multiple secondary schools the access is similar. Each student can have two parent/guardian email addresses associated with them that will have access to their school information.

Final Report Cards for the 2019-20 school year will be posted to the portal on *Thursday, June 25, 2020* at 2pm.

Extended Deadline/Modified High School Admission Requirements

- 1. BC Grade 12 (or equivalent) graduation.
- 2. BC English 12/English 12 First Peoples with a minimum of 67% (or equivalent)
- 3. Pre-Calculus 12 with a minimum of 67% (or equivalent)
- 4. Physics 12 with a minimum of 67% (or equivalent)
- 5. Chemistry 12 with a minimum of **67%** (or equivalent). (You will still be considered for admission if you do not fulfill the Chemistry 12 requirements, however you may have to complete an extra Chemistry course)



Coquitlam Continuing Education

The school district will be opening registration soon for summertime Grade 10-12 high school credit courses. The following two options will be provided as Distributed Learning through Coquitlam Open Learning:

Coquitlam Open Learning Gr 10-12:

Grade 10-12 full credit courses

Free to eligible school-aged BC Residents aged 13 to 19 years old.

Registration available to students enrolled in SD43 schools only, starting this Friday May 8, 2020. Students are not eligible for courses they are currently taking in their current schools, (they can take those starting in July, including Fast Track)

Online courses with flexible start dates which should be completed within 10 months of registration. Students will participate in various online activities which may include Moodle online lessons, online discussions, and e-mail interactions with the teacher. Students can begin these courses within a few days after registering.

Fast Track Gr 10-12: Complete a full credit course from July 2 to August 3:

Fast Track courses follow a blended learning model:

- two weekly synchronous class sessions (Tues/Thurs or Wed/Fri, mornings or afternoons (see specific courses for scheduling). These class sessions will most likely be conducted online.
- three days of online work. Teachers will be available these days for online tutorial support.

Note: This program is best suited for students wishing to complete the selected course within a 6-week timeline.

Program Dates: July 2 - August 7 (Note: there will be no tutorials July 27 and August 3)
