


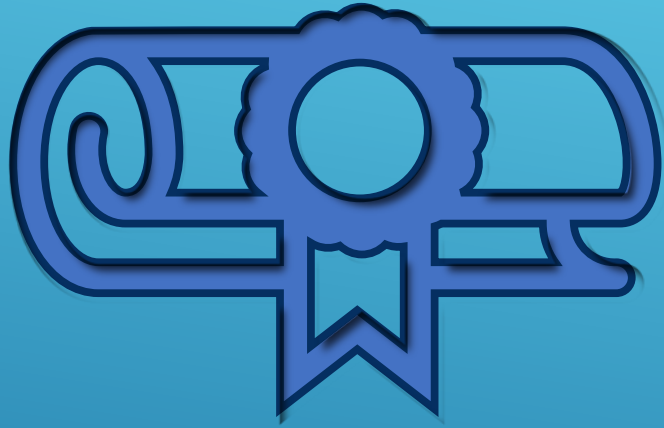

# COURSE SELECTION GRADE 11 IB DIPLOMA

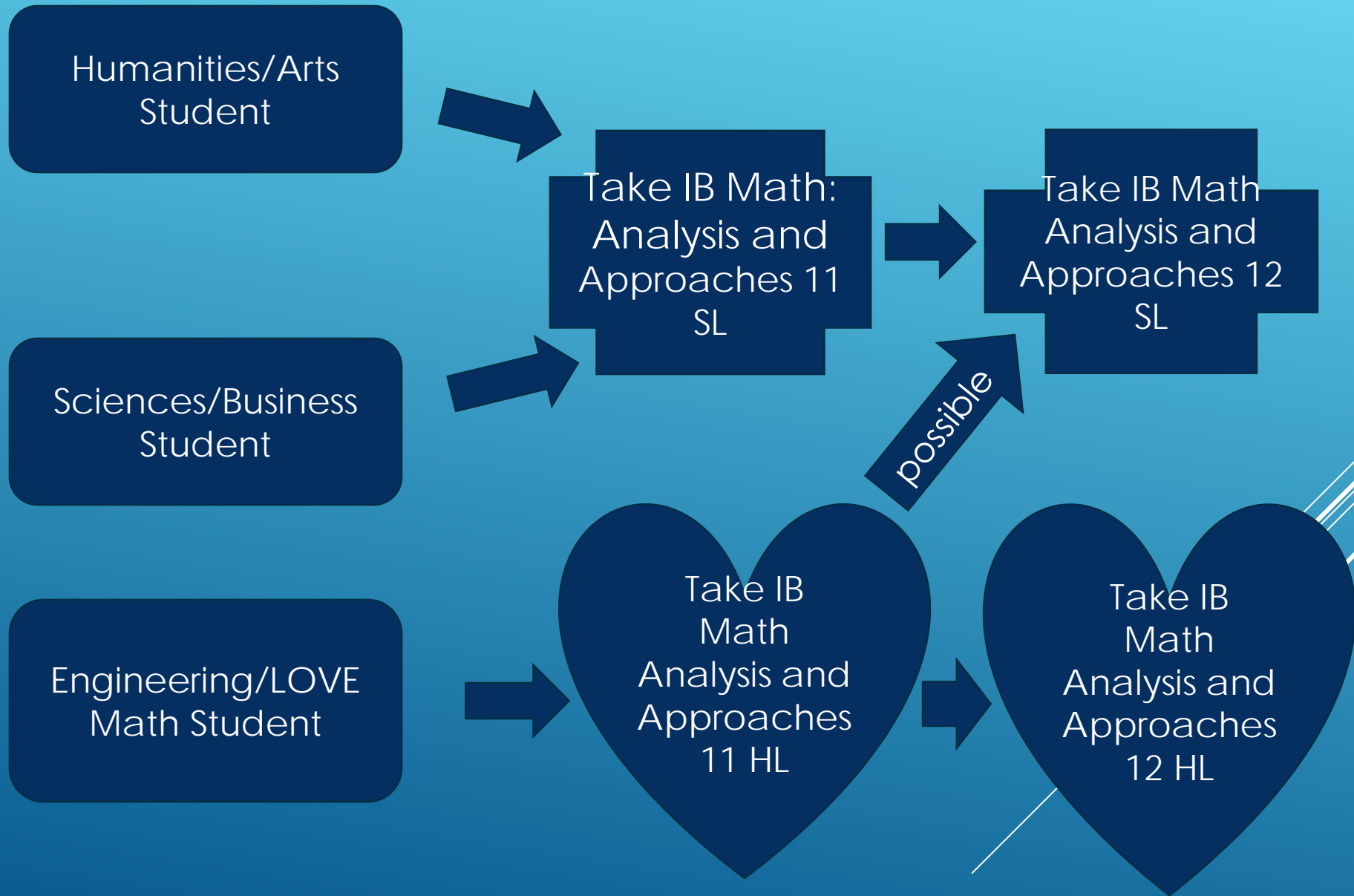
Group	Course Choices
Group 1	IB English A: Literature 11 HL
Group 2	IB Language 11 <del>AND IB Language 12 SL</del> (French, Spanish, Mandarin, or Japanese)
Group 3	IB History 11 HL or IB Geography 11 HL or IB Economics 11 SL
Group 4	IB Biology 11 HL or IB Chemistry 11 SL or IB Physics HL/SL
Group 5	IB Mathematics: Analysis and Approaches 11 SL or HL
Group 6	IB Visual Arts 11 HL/SL or a second choice from group 2-4.
Core	IB Theory of Knowledge 11 IB CAS 11 and IB Extended Essay 11

Minimum of 3 HL courses, maximum of 4 HL course for Diploma.  
Limit of **8 Courses**  
Music may be a **9<sup>th</sup>** option

- ▶ Decide what you want to study.
  - ▶ Arts (History, Psychology, Linguistics, Political Science, Mathematics (?)...)
  - ▶ Sciences (Chemistry, Biology, Geo-physics, Physics, Mathematics...)
  - ▶ Business (Commerce, Management, Economics...)
  - ▶ Applied Sciences or Engineering
  - ▶ Much, much more...
- ▶ Make a list of universities you may want to attend.
- ▶ Go to their websites and search for IB admission requirements.
- ▶ Canadian universities will typically have faculty specific requirements.
- ▶ Go where you are wanted!
- ▶ **Don't listen to the rumour mill**– do your own research and think for yourself.

# POST SECONDARY INFORMATION

Arts Degree: Typically need English Lit and graduate from high school/earn your diploma

Business/Commerce Degree: Typically need English Lit, Math A&A SL, and earn your diploma/graduate from high school

Science Degree: Typically need English Lit, Math A&A SL, 2 Sciences, and earn your diploma/graduate from high school

\*UBC and SFU ask for Physics 11 and Chemistry 11; UBC only requires 1 gr 12 Science, SFU requires 2

\*Take IB Physics 11&12, take Chemistry 11 at summer school and qualify for UBC

\*Take IB Biology 11& 12, take IB Chemistry 11 & 12, take Physics 11 at summer school and qualify for either.

\*Etc etc

Engineering Degrees: Typically need English Lit, Math A&A HL, Physics and Chemistry at Gr 12 level, and earn your diploma/graduate from high school

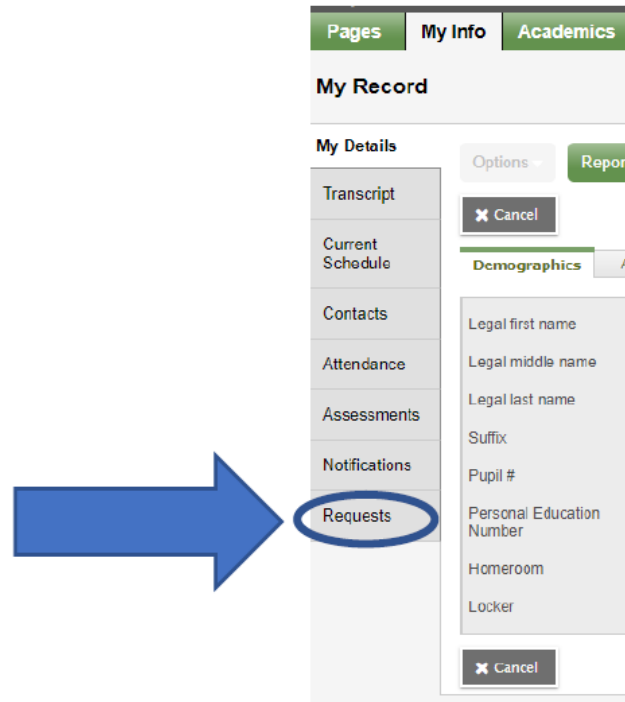
## How To Make Course Selections on MyEd

### Step 1: Log in to MyEd

- When you are at the main menu, you will select the “My Info” button from the top menu options.

### Instructions

Our school's timetable is based on your requests; therefore, the choices you make are important. Please refer to the PRSS Course Calendar as your guide.

Read through the Course Calendar and be thoughtful about your choices. **Course changes later in the year are frequently not possible.**

All grade 10's take a minimum of 8 courses - **6 required courses** and **2 electives**.

Four of your required courses have been programmed for you:

1. Social Studies 10
2. Physical Health Education 10
3. Science 10
4. Career Life Education 10

In the section below you will need to select an English 10 course, a Math 10 course and 2 electives.

**Primary Requests**  
Choose an English 10 course: There are 4 different options for English 10 at Port Moody. You will choose one.  
Choose a Math 10 course: There are two choices at the grade 10 level.  
Choose 2 electives: Refer to the course calendar for details to help you make your choices.  
Choose an extra elective: This step is optional. A regular high school timetable has 8 courses. The courses in this screen happen outside the regular timetable, so participation in these courses means you will be taking a 9th course.

**Alternate Requests**  
Choose 2 alternate electives: If your elective choices in the previous screen are full, we will try and give you the classes you choose in the screen as alternates.

When you are finished, click 'Post' in the bottom left corner of your screen. You can return and edit your selections as many times as you like until Tuesday, February 9.

## Step 4: Share notes with your counsellor

You can also let counsellors know of Summer School plans that you have. The counsellor will add one of your Alternate electives in place of the class you plan to complete at summer school.
