Good afternoon grade 12 students and Parents/ Guardians,

I am writing to you today with information on how and when we will honour your graduation. We recognize many of you have seen and discussed the letters sent by other schools and apologize for any angst created while waiting for our second letter on the topic of your graduation. Our approach was to wait for the most recent provincial updates (presented last week) before speaking with your Grad Council and finalizing our plans. Our rationale for waiting:

- No one was certain what new information was to be presented to the province prior to Premier Horgan's announcement on May 6th.
- 2. The district had issued a graduation letter to families on April 29th reflecting the guidelines we as schools were to collectively follow. However, it was slightly amended a week later to allow principals to consider bringing students to the school for photographs and / or video opportunities. We wanted to be certain there were no further district adjustments before proceeding with our school's planning.
- 3. We feel it is best to provide as much information as possible in one letter, rather than sending a series of messages for you to collate. Page 2 has a timeline of events.

We know that nothing can replace the loss of so many expected events and activities in your final semester in high school. While so much is being shared about Commencement, we also talk often of what other experiences you have missed. Like being the senior players on our teams, performing one last time at the year-end concerts, attending the annual Spring Fling, sitting together on a sunny day in June, and of course Dinner / Dance. We also think about the uncertainty you face in the coming months as you prepare for work, school, moving cities, moving countries, commuting...the list of questions about simply navigating the logistics of what's next is quite lengthy.

Ultimately, we hope you are well and healthy, and remain that way. In speaking with some of the grad class, I very much admire your collective outlook, thoughtfulness, and adaptability. How you have responded to what you have gone through, and how you are already addressing the challenges to come, is both inspiring to our current community and a legacy to future grad classes.
