Description and Deadlines

- Approximately 37 student awards to be granted
- PMSS Scholarship committee will select **one** graduating student for nomination
- Will cover tuition, books, incidental fees, and full residence support for four years
- Scholarship is tenable **only at the University of Toronto**
- To become a Pearson Scholar, you must be nominated by your school and apply to undergraduate studies at the University of Toronto in September 2020.
- Schools' nomination deadline: November 27, 2020
- Apply to the University of Toronto through the Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC) before the deadline of December 13, 2020. <u>RECOMMENDED</u> OUAC application date: November 7, 2020 spaces in programs fill-up quickly and popular programs may close early.
- Once you've been nominated <u>and</u> have applied to the University of Toronto, you will be sent a personalized, secure link to the Lester B. Pearson International Scholarship application which must be completed by *January 15, 2021*

Criteria

The scholarship program is intended to recognize a student who:

- Demonstrates exceptional academic achievement and creativity
- Is recognized as a leader within PMSS
- Has had an impact on the life of their school and community
- Has the potential to contribute positively to the global community

Please submit the following documents to complete your application to Ms. Campbell or Ms. Chang by *November 27, 2020:*

- 1. A cover letter, which indicates the way that you meet the criteria: a high achiever in both academic and creative pursuits, a *recognized leader* at PMSS who had made an impact on the school <u>and</u> the community, and who denonstrates potential to contribute to the global community.
- 2. A resume or a completed Brag Book that includes all your school, community, and work-related activities.
