
BCIT BRIDGEWATCH PROGRAM

WHAT IS A MACHINIST?

A Machinist is someone who turns blocks of metal into complex, intricate metal parts for other products. They fit and assemble metal parts and sub-assemblies, ensuring the parts in these products meet exacting standards in size, strength and hardness. A Machinist sets up and operates all machine tools such as Lathes, Milling Machines Saws, Grinding Machines, Drilling and Boring Machines, Shapers, Planers, Precision Measuring tools, Hand and Power tools, and the related attachments and accessories, including CNC-machining, selection, use and maintenance of cutting tools.

WHEN CAN I TAKE THE PROGRAM?

This program is available to student in grades 11 & 12. The program is 33 weeks long and will take place at BCIT. Students can choose to start the program in either September or January. Students must apply for the program through the SD43 Trades Programs. **CLICK HERE** to view application.

- Evaluating and recommending the apprentice for certification
