# **Choir and Christmas Concert Information**

## Lougheed Mall Choir Performance (Dec. 15th):

• We will gather inside the entrance on the lower level next to the Body Shop store at **5:45pm sharp**. Here, the singers can pass their coats on to you and get into formation before heading to the performance area at 6pm, which is in front of London Drugs. All choir members are again expected to wear their choir attire:

> -Boys: in white shirts and ties with black pants -Girls: in white tops with black pants or skirts

## Christmas Concert (Holiday Moosical) Guidelines (Dec. 21st):

• All students are expected to attend both concerts (2:00pm and 7:00pm). If your child cannot make it to one or both of the concerts, please let your homeroom teacher know as soon as possible.

• If your child is in Gr. 3 and in choir, they will stay in their choir outfit (white on top, black on bottom) for the entire concert. They will keep their white shirt, but will put on additional props (headbands, feathers, beaks, etc.) when switching from the Choir Act to the Primary Act (Gr. 1-3).
