



This Week in Review:

Hello everyone,

There is still room in our afterschool programs, though they are filling up quickly. The "Game Ready Crazy Sports" and "Illustrating NorthWest Coast Animals" sessions started this week and were very much





enjoyed by students. The "Robotics" and the Place des Arts "Mixed Media, Collage and Sculpture" programs start next week. Please note that we want any interested student to be able to participate. If there is a financial difficulty, please reach out to me.

The Coquitlam Library Book Bus is coming January 23rd! Please make sure that your child signs up for their Coquitlam library card, or bring their existing card. You can sign up for their library card <u>at this link</u>. Library staff will bring the cards on the 23rd.

One of our school goals this year is developing a common understanding of foundational mathematical terms and using the terms consistently across grades. This week's term is "**count on**", and it means to count up or down from a



number given. You can count on by any number. In the younger grades we will count on from zero by ones (1, 2, 3...), by twos (2, 4, 6...), fives (5, 10, 15...) or tens (10, 20, 30...). This helps build understanding for addition and ultimately multiplication. You can also count backwards to build skills for subtraction. Finally, you can count on from a specific number (count on by 3s from 12 - 12, 15, 18, 21...) to build skills that can be used in specific math problems.

The MDI, or Middle Years Development Instrument, is a survey completed by all Grade 4 students. It will take about an hour, and will be done on Thursday morning.

Decompose – to break a number into smaller parts. Round to - make a number friendly by finding the closest multiple of 10. Subitize - to recognize the number of a small group of objects without counting. Count on – to count up or down from a number given.
