Decompose – to break a number into smaller parts. Round to - make a number friendly by finding the closest multiple of 10. Subitize - to recognize the number of a small group of objects without counting. Count on – to count up or down from a number given. Library Bus

Mariner Way - Street Lighting Upgrades and Road Repaving Project

The scope of the project includes:

- repaving Mariner Way from Como Lake Avenue to Pilot Drive;
- repaving of Beach Court;
- installing "no left turn" signage on Mariner Way at Dolphin Street;
- repairing sections of sidewalk; and
- new installations and upgrading of street lights along Mariner Way from Daybreak Avenue to Dewdney Trunk Road. The new street lights will be LED and will provide more lighting which will improve visibility and safety.

Construction will take about 3 months to complete. The contractor will start with the electrical and sidewalk work, then move on to the road repaying work.

Work will take place Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Construction will affect traffic flow but every effort will be made to minimize disruption.
