Students

- We are working on ensuring hallways and washrooms are as safe and welcoming as possible. We enforce our Code of Conduct. In past few weeks, we've seen an improvement in general behaviors in those areas.

- Grads are also organizing the Grade 11 & 12 winter formal dance: well underway, and will take place Dec 6.
- Clubs and teams very active at the moment, with Senior Girls volleyball and Sr. Boys soccer both progressing well. Other sports did amazing and have wrapped up their seasons.

Affordability Fund use

- Update, we are about to start a free breakfast kiosk with cereal and fruit every morning. Location: the kiosk. Should get going next week.
- We are currently paying for buses for field trips so families pay less on those experiences until funds run out.

AfterGrad

- Working on Winter Market, Fundscript, and Meridian at the moment
- Jan-March will be the more Online & Pub type fundraisers. These are the ones Jon will move out to a sub-committee of PAC... maybe refer to it AfterGrad Fundraising. Jon is planning to send that invite out after Winter Market is over.
- AfterGrad itself is being organized by the school. Early processes underway for a repeat of last year, but this time we will host at the school. Buses are booked, so kids will be transported from Hotel to School and then released at end of AfterGrad (3am projected).
