Kamyar Ednoddin Hamidi attended Riverside Secondary School in both his grade 9 and 10 years, where he excelled in technology, as well as his language skills within the French Immersion Program. In just two years, Kam made quite an impression as he was always willing to help others. He would easily form connections with his peers as he would discuss music, concerts, popular culture, and video games amongst other items. Tragically, Kam passed away as part of the Flight 752 crash on January 8th, 2020, which took the lives of 176 individuals, which also included both of his parents Ardalan Ebnoddin Hamidi and Niloufar Khamsi Razzaghi. Although Kam will not be able to live out his academic potential, this scholarship has been created to help others achieve theirs in his name.

\$1, 000 will be awarded to two 2025 graduating Riverside Secondary students.

Eligibility/Criteria:

- applicant must be a current Riverside Secondary grade student, graduating in 2025
- applicant must have at least a “B” grade in all of their grade 12 courses
- student must excel and demonstrate an understanding of technology to some extent
- student must be personable and willing to assist others

All winning applicants will be notified prior to Riverside’s Awards Night and a cheque will be issued in the recipient's name, where the amount will need to be cashed within 12 months.
